### Topic- At the Supermarket

<p>Write a shopping list.</p> <p>This could be to help your parent buy the things they need.</p> <p>Or Write a list of things to buy in your 'play' supermarket.</p> <p>Why do we write a list when we go shopping?</p>	<p>Ask a parent to share some coins with you- 1p, 2p, 5p and 10p.</p> <p>What do we need money for?</p> <p>Coin hunt- hide the coins around the house/ garden. Can you say what coins you find?</p> <p><u>Challenge yourself- use 20p, 50p, £1, £2</u></p>	<p><u>ICT (Internet Safety 1)</u></p> <p>When we visit a supermarket we must follow rules.</p> <p>Talk about following safety rules when we visit somewhere (this is linked to visiting places on the internet)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Always go places with an adult.</li> <li>• Don't wander off on your own.</li> <li>• Talk only with people you know.</li> </ul> <p>Discuss these.</p>	<p>Play colour 'I spy'. I spy something that is orange...blue...black</p> <p>Can you say the colours in Welsh?</p> <p>Coch-red Melyn- yellow Pinc-pink Glas-blue Porffor-purple Oren-orange Gwyrdd- green Du- black</p>	<p>Pencil control- Ask an adult to draw zip zag lines/ loops on paper. Can you draw over them? Remember not to go out of the lines.</p> <p><u>Practise holding your pencil using the tripod grip.</u></p> <p><b>Tripod Grip</b></p>  <p>1 - Tall Finger (side) 2 - Thumb (pad) 3 - Pointing Finger (tip) All fingers are slightly bent.</p>	<p>Listen to Jaime in her Zen Den</p> <p>(Search YouTube, Cosmic Kids, Zen Den)</p>

Take notice of what you see, smell or hear.</p> <p>At the end take a few deep breaths and smile.</p>

Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access the reading material on <a href="http://www.activlearnprimary.co.uk">www.activlearnprimary.co.uk</a></li> <li>• Sing the Jolly Phonics sounds songs and do the actions. These can be found on YouTube.</li> <li>• Learn 1, 2 or 3 new tricky words a week (these were given on a laminated sheet before Christmas) play pairs/ snap/display them around the house.</li> </ul>
Writing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Practise writing letters correctly- children can trace over your letters to begin with then write them independently.</li> <li>• Practise writing your name, first name then surname.</li> <li>• Practise writing your tricky words ( focus on the ones you have chosen to learn to read)</li> </ul>
Number	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Count to 10, 20...</li> <li>• Learn doubles up to 5 1+1=2, 2+2=4, 3+3=6, 4+4=8,5+5=10</li> <li>• Practise number formation.</li> </ul>
Physical/ Well-being	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• YouTube- Joe Wicks PE</li> <li>• YouTube – Zen Den Cosmic Kids</li> <li>• Go for a daily walk</li> </ul>
