## Topic- Mini Zoo and Nursery Rhymes (Pet Week)

**If possible please select 3 learning tasks each day, Monday to Friday**

Talk about pets! What is a pet? What animals make/ do not make a good pet? Where do pets live? What do pets eat?	What number comes before? Use a number line to 5/10/20 or above. Adult chooses a number and asks What number comes before....?	Roll a lump of lard into a ball. Coat in bird seed to make a fat ball for the birds in your garden. Why do we need to feed the wild birds in Winter?	Use paints, felts and bits and pieces to make a collage picture of goldfish in a tank.	Play with a ball to practise your bouncing skills	Listen along and join in with "I have a Pet" song on You Tube.
Keep practising writing your name. Make your letters as small and neat as you can.	Keep practising writing numbers to 10/20 or above. How far can you get?	Turn your daily walk into a number and letters walk What numbers and letters can you see?	Improve your picture making. Practise drawing a dog, a fish, a bird, a cat, a mouse, a rabbit etc.	Join in with Joe Wicks PE	Sing and dance along to your favourite song
Listen to the story of "The New Dog" on You Tube. Talk about what happened when the family chose Floppy.	Make a set of toys, sweets etc. Count the set. Can you find the right number for the total of the set? How high can you go?	Go on a hunt in each room to find all of the things that need electricity to work.	Draw a picture of your pet.	Practise your scissor skills. Cut thin strips of paper to stick on to a piece of card to make it look like a hamster cage.	Have a game of "Simon Says" Simon says... jump, run, hop, lie down, roll, sleep, dance etc. Try it faster each time.
Practise writing Jolly Phonic sounds. Try writing the words:- dog, cat, fish, pet, bird, mouse, rabbit	By using soft toys change your shop into a Pet Shop. Use coins to buy or sell. Ask may I have...? How much is...? Can you name the coins?	Look on the internet for a clip showing how to care for a pet.	Decorate an old sock to make a puppet of a pet.	Take part in a Yoga for Kids session on You Tube.	Listen to and sing along to Lliwiau'r Enfys/Sing a rainbow on You Tube
Keep practising asking and answering why and when questions:- e.g. When do you clean your teeth? Why do you clean your teeth?	Start at 1 How far can you count to? Try to get higher each time. Play "Hide and seek" to practise your counting.	Find out 5 facts about a dog	Use potatoes to print a cat's head and body. When the paint is dry use felt pens to add eyes, ears, whiskers, tail etc. How many different cats can you design?	You need 5 soft toys in a row on the floor. Label the toys 1-5 or 5-10 or above. Roll a ball to touch the toy of your choice. Write down the number of the toy the ball touched.	Find a quiet area with a family member and enjoy having a story
