| Listen to an animal story on You Tube | Play a shopping game to learn to recognise simple coins. How many do you know? | Find out 3 facts about a robin | Create a junk model of a bird in a nest | Find different ways of travelling around the garden – hop, march, jump etc. | Practise drawing a happy face |
| Practise writing Jolly Phonic sounds on an outside wall or patio, using water and a paintbrush | You tube- counting songs The singing Walrus | Learn the names of the parts of a bird – feathers, beak, wing, | Make a collage picture of a face using grass and leaves | Use scissors to practise cutting around an object e.g. pictures from a magazine or newspaper | Roll up a piece of card to make a trumpet.
