Talk about the signs of Winter. What do we wear in Winter? What is the weather like in Winter? What do we play in Winter? What happens to the trees in Winter?	What number comes next? Use a number line to 10/20. Adult chooses a number and asks What number comes next?	Put a tub of water in the freezer overnight. Watch it thaw during the day. Can you describe what has happened?	Use paints, felts and bits and pieces to make a snowy collage picture.	Play with a ball to practise throwing and catching skills	Listen along and join in with The Penguin Song on You Tube.
Keep practising writing your name. Make your letters as small and neat as you can.	Keep practising writing numbers to 10/20 or above. How far can you get?	Turn your daily walk into a shape walk. What shapes can you see?	Improve your picture making. Practise drawing a jolly snowman.	Join in with Joe Wicks PE	Sing and dance along to your favourite song
Listen to the story of "Sneezy the Snowman" on You Tube. Talk about what happened to the snowman.	Make a set of toys, sweets etc. Count the set. Can you find the right number for the total of the set?	Think of things that are hot. Think of things that are cold	Draw a picture of yourself. Ask an adult to post it on Google Classroom so that we can all see it?	Practise your scissor skills. Cut out some large letters from a newspaper or a magazine. Stick them onto a piece of card.	Think of all of the favourite things that you like to eat
Sprinkle some flour on a tray. Practise writing Jolly Phonic sounds.	Use toys, tins, shoes etc. to make a shop. Use coins to buy or sell. Ask may I have...? How much is...? Can you name the coins?	Look on the internet for a clip showing penguins in the snow	Write your name on a piece of card. Make and decorate a sign for your bedroom door.	Take part in a Yoga for Kids session on You Tube.	Ask an adult to cut up some fruit. Enjoy a fruit picnic at story time.
Keep practising asking and answering questions:- e.g. What is your favourite food? What is your favourite colour? Who is your best friend?	Start at 1 How far can you count to? Try to get higher each time.	Find out 3 facts about a penguin	Practise drawing a snowman face. Draw a circle, coal eyes, carrot nose, stick mouth and a top hat	You need an empty bucket and a small ball. Try throwing the ball into the bucket. Use a pencil and paper to write down your score	Find a quiet area with a family member and enjoy having a story
