During this difficult time we want to do all that we can to support you and your child. We understand that the main priority is staying safe and well whilst following the Government guidance. However, we remain committed to ensuring your child receives a high quality education and continues to develop essential skills through a structured 'home learning' approach.

We do appreciate that 'home learning' is particularly challenging with many different factors coming in to play. We ask that parents/carers work with us as educators to support pupils in accessing as much as is reasonably possible.

Year 6 staff will:

- Provide a weekly learning timetable for pupils to follow
- Plan engaging learning in line with the Year 6 curriculum expectations
- Plan learning activities which promote a broad and balanced curriculum
- Provide two Google Classroom lessons a day
- Allocate time and provide lessons for pupils to develop and look after their well-being
- Provide written feedback to pupils on Google Classroom
- Provide lessons which allow pupils to respond in writing
- Be available to answer queries on Google Classroom between 10:00am – 11:00am and 2:30pm – 3:00pm daily
- Be available via telephone conversation to answer any technical or learning queries

Year 6 pupils are asked to:

- Access Hwb Google For Education daily
- Complete the on-line lessons to the best of their ability
- Submit work on Google Classroom daily
- Remain active, hydrated and positive in their attitude to learning
- Complete Big Maths on-line weekly
- Access Active learn reading materials daily for 15 minutes
- Contact the class teacher via Google Classroom for additional support

Year 6 parents are asked to:

- Support their child in engaging with on-line learning
- Contact the school or class teacher for further learning support
- Visit the school website regularly to keep up to date with information
